GAME NOTES

- ➔ **GETTING ON THE RIGHT TRACK:** The Flames are 2-0-2 lthe ast two weeks with two wins in the middle. Lee has posted seven goals in their last four contests.
- ➔ **TAKING ON USC RANKED OPPONENTS:** Tonight will be the third time the Flames have faced a Top 25 teams in the United Soccer Coaches poll this season. Lee tied then #20 Lincoln Memorial 1-1 on September 11 and beat #23 West Alabama 3-1 last Friday night.
- ➔ **SCOUTING THE WARHAWKS:** AUM is playing its first home match since the opening three games. They have recorded ties in their last three contests with the last two posting a 0-0 score. The Warhawks have scored four goals (0.80 per game) and allowed just one (0.20 per game) in their five games this season. AUM's goalkeepers have combined for four shutouts. William Blake (1-0-2) has allowed one goal in 225 minutes, while Alfie Rule (1-0-1) has yet to allow a goal after 225 minutes in goal.
- ➔ **CONFERENCE TEAMS MAKE UP MOST OF REMAINING SCHEDULE:** Nine of the Flames' final 10 contests will be against Gulf South Conference opponents. The lone non-conference date remaining is October 12 at Lander.
- ➔ **NEXT HOME DATES:** The Flames travel to Montevallo on Sunday to continue the GSC road trip before returning home on October 4 to take on Spring Hill College.
