## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **REGULAR SEASON HOME OPENER:** Tonight's game is the fourth regular season game for Lee and first at home. Bryan will be treating the game as an exhibition.
- ➔ **ABOUT THE BRYAN LEADER:** This is Matt Bollant's second stint with Bryan. He went 134-36 over five years before leaving for Wisconsin-Green Bay where his teams were 148-19 in five seasons, followed by five years at Illinois (61-94) and seven seasons at Eastern Illinois (96-111).
- ➔ **RECENT OUTINGS:** The Lady Flames won 70-52 at Emmanuel on Saturday. Mallory Hampton led Lee with 14 points and five rebounds, while Haylee Johnson had 11 points and five boards. Addison Smith had a team-high six rebounds to go along with six points.
- ➔ **SCORING DIFFERENTIAL:** Lee is averaging 69.3 points over their first three games and have given up an average of 57.3 points for a +12.0 scoring margin.
- ➔ **IN THE RANKINGS:** The Lady Flames are ranked #15 in this week's D2GSC poll and are second in the South Region behind Tampa. Lee received votes in the preseason WBCA Coaches Poll.
- ➔ **MAKING A MARK IN THE RECORD BOOK:** Mallory Hampton has scored 1,391 points in her collegiate career with 1,098 of those coming at Lee. She made 179 free throws last year with a free throw percentage of .861, which are fourth and third all-time, respectively, at Lee.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Lady Flames complete their non-conference slate with Kentucky State on Nov. 23 and Covenant College on Nov. 25.
