- ◆ **ABOUT THE SCOTS:** Covenant is a member of NCAA Division III and the Collegiate College of the South (CCS). Covenant opened the season with an 87-69 win over Warren Wilson followed by losses to Principia (72-67) and Sewanee (72-64). The Scots won 64-50 at Welch on Thursday and lost 60-57 at home to Pensacola Christian on Saturday.
- **➡ RECENT OUTINGS:** Lee beat Kentucky State 77-54 on Saturday after leading 37-19 at the half. Mallory Hampton led all scorers with 18 points to go with four assists and three steals. Anna Muhonen added 14 points, while Haylee Johnson supplied 11 points and six assists.
- SCORING DIFFERENTIAL: Lee is averaging 71.0 points over their first five games and have given up an average of 52.6 points for a +18.4 scoring margin.
- IN THE RANKINGS: The Lady Flames are ranked #13 in last week's D2CSC poll and are second in the South Region behind Tampa. Lee is #24 in the latest WBCA Coaches Poll.
- **♦ MAKING A MARK IN THE RECORD BOOK:** Mallory Hampton has scored 1,426 points in her collegiate career with 1,133 of those coming at Lee. She has moved to 14th position on the Lee career scoring list with her total points. Her Lee-only tally puts her at No. 24, just two points shy of Melanie Tullock's 1.135.
- LOOKING AHEAD: The Lady Flames begin GSC competition next week with trips to Montevallo (Dec. 5) and AUM (Dec. 7). Lee returns home Dec. 12 to take on West Alabama.
