- POSTSEASON SCENARIOS: Lee is currently in third place just one-half game behind UAH (18-4). With a win today, the Lady Flames will finish second. A loss will drop them to third place.
- REGION RANKINGS: The Lady Flames landed at No. 5 in this week's South Region rankings. Embry-Riddle is first with Union second. Tampa is at No. 3 with Nova Southeastern at No. 4.
- ► HOME SWEET HOME: Lee is 12-1 at home this season and had a 12-game win streak snapped in a January 23 loss to AUM. Since becoming full members of the GSC and NCAA DII in 2015-16, the Lady Flames have amassed a 124-21 record at home.
- MAKING A MARK IN THE RECORD BOOK: Mallory Hampton is No. 11 on the Lee career scoring list with 1,686 points. Her Lee-only tally (1,393) puts her at No. 16, just three points behind Jan (Dodson) Spangler and five points behind Chrissy Andreson (1,398)
- GSC LEADERS: Mallory Hampton has slid to third in GSC scoring with 16.8 ppg. Hampton is second in FG% (.509) and first in FT% (.884). Haylee Johnson is first in assists average (5.3 apg) with Hampton in fifth (3.6 apg). Johnson is also first with 144 total assists.
- SCORING DIFFERENTIAL: Lee is averaging 68.3 points and have given up an average of 54.8 points for a +13.6 scoring margin. The points allowed are fewest in the GSC. Lee is fourth in scoring offense and third in scoring margin. UU is the highest scoring team at 85.6 ppg and are best with a scoring margin of +18.6. UU allows 67.0 ppg (8th-fewest in GSC).
- LOOKING AHEAD: The Lady Flames will host a GSC Quarterfinal game on Tuesday. Opponent is TBD.
