GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee outscored UAH 39-18 to sweep the three-game GSC series this past weekend. Casen Youngblood blasted three home runs and drove in nine runs to lead the Lee offense.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 3-0 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 43-45 and were 9-9 in neutral-site games. Lee is 4-0 at C-N during that period.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Lee has four players with active hit streaks of at least six. Braden Gabel has hit safely in the last eight games and Isaiah French has a hit in seven straight, while Luke Collier and Casen Youngblood have hits in each of the last six games. Landon Franklin and French have reached base safely in 13 straight games.
- ➔ **OUT OF CONFERENCE:** The Flames are 7-0 against non-conference opponents. They were just 8-7 outside of conference in the regular season last year and are 63-38 since 2020.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Luke Collier is tied for first with 18 runs scored, Landon Franklin is tied for fifth (16) and Isaiah French is tied for 10th (13). Collier is tied for sixth with 17 hits. French and Casen Youngblood are tied with two others with four home runs. French is tied for fourth with 17 RBI, while Collier is tied for seventh (14). French is tied for fifth with 10 walks and tied for third with six hit by pitch. Evan Bloomer leads the GSC with 25.1 innings pitched and is tied for sixth with 22 Ks.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return home this weekend for a GSC series with AUM before going back on the road to face Lincoln Memorial (March 3) and Union University (March 6-7). Lee then hosts Carson-Newman on March 10.

C-N won two of three before that following three straight wins by Lee. C-N won nine of the first 12, including two three-game win streaks.


