GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee lost its third straight with a 6-5 loss to visiting Carson-Newman on Tuesday evening. The Flames committed two errors in the first two innings as the Eagles grabbed a 6-0 lead after two. Luke Collier drilled a solo home run in the third inning, while Aiden McClary had an RBI single and scored on Ryan Valdes' double in the sixth. Valdes drove in another run in the eighth and Nate Caraballo's ninth inning sacrifice fly pulled Lee within one with two men on and only one out. The next two batters were retired to end Lee's comeback hopes.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 5-3 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 45-48 and are 9-9 in neutral-site games.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Aiden McClary has a current hit streak of eight games. The longest of the season was 11 by Casen Youngblood and Braden Gabel. Isaiah French has reached base safely in all 22 of the team's games this season. JJ Williams has reached safely in 11 straight and Aiden McClary 10 in a row.
- ➔ **POLL FACTOR:** Six of Lee's seven losses have come while the Flames were ranked or receiving votes in one of the national polls. Lee was ranked No. 17 in the NCBWA prior to being swept by Delta State. On Tuesday the ABCA poll was released with the Flames receiving votes. Later that day, Lee was handed its fourth loss of the year at LMU and lost two of three at Union last weekend.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames travel to Young Harris on Tuesday before returning home to host Christian Brothers in a GSC series next weekend.
