GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee fell behind Tusculum 7-0 after three innings and their comeback attempt fell short after scoring five in the top of the ninth of a 12-9 loss on the road. JJ Williams was 3-for-5 to lead the Flames' 11 hit attack.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 6-7 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 46-52 and are 9-9 in neutral-site games.
- ➔ **LOOKING TO TURN THINGS AROUND:** After starting the season 14-3, the Flames lost seven of their next nine contests. Lee won three last weekend and lost at Tusculum on Tuesday.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Lee is leading the GSC with a team BAvG. of .325, while UM is 10th (.267). The Flames are tops in home runs (34), RBI (234) and runs scored (258). UM is fourth (29) in home runs, ninth in RBI (154) and 10th in runs scored (168). Lee has also stolen a GSC-leading 70 bases to 33 (11th) for UM. Montevallo has struck out 269 batters (No. 2), while Lee has fanned 224 (sixth).
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Luke Collier owns Lee's longest current hitting streak at nine. Cody Turner is next at seven. Aiden McClary, Casen Youngblood and Braden Gabel have the longest streaks of the season at 11. Isaiah French had his reached base safely streak snapped at 29 on Tuesday. JJ Williams has reached safely in 19 straight, McClary 18 and Cody Turner is at 15 in a row.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** Lee continues its seven-game road stretch. After this weekend, Lee travels to North Georgia for a mid-week game followed by a GSC series at West Florida next weekend.


