GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee had its eight-game win streak snapped by Lincoln Memorial 6-5 in 10 innings. The Flames scored three runs in the ninth to force extra innings before LMU walked-off with an RBI single in the 10th. Braden Gabel had three hits to lead Lee. JJ Williams had a team-leading two RBI.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 4-1 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 44-46 and are 9-9 in neutral-site games.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Lee has two players with active hit streaks of 10+. Braden Gabel has hit safely in 11 straight games, while Casen Youngblood is at 10. Isaiah French has reached base in all 18 games.
- ➔ **POLL FACTOR:** All four of Lee's losses have come while the Flames were ranked or receiving votes in one of the national polls. Lee was ranked No. 17 in the NCBWA prior to being swept by Delta State. On Tuesday the ABCA poll was released with the Flames receiving votes. Later that day, Lee was handed its fourth loss of the year at LMU.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Braden Gabel leads the GSC with a .472 batting average with Isaiah French right behind at .418. French's OPS of 1.389 leads the GSC and his six home runs is tied for first with three others. Casen Youngblood is tied with two others for fifth with five home runs. Luke Collier is first in runs scored (23), while French and Landon Franklin are tied with three others for third (20).
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return home to host Carson-Newman on Tuesday before traveling to Clinton, Miss., to take on Mississippi College next weekend.

Lee also recorded a nine-game win streak in 2014 to 2016. UU won the first three games in the series. Lee posted two more two-game win streaks split by four straight wins by UU.
