GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee ended a five-game non-conference loss streak with an 8-6 win at #17/#10 North Georgia. Luke Collier was 3-for-5 with two doubles and a home run. Braden Gabel added three singles to Lee's 15-hit attack.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 8-9 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 48-54 and are 9-9 in neutral-site games.
- ➔ **LOOKING TO TURN THINGS AROUND:** After starting the season 14-3, the Flames lost seven of their next nine contests. Lee then won three straight before losing three of the last five.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Luke Collier owns Lee's longest current hitting streak at 13. Aiden McClary, Casen Youngblood and Braden Gabel had the longest streaks of the season at 11. Isaiah French had his reached base safely streak snapped at 29 against Tusculum. JJ Williams has reached safely in 23 straight and McClary is at 22.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** The Flames lead the GSC in runs (323), hits (389), triples (10), home runs (45), RBI (293), walks (168), stolen bases (76) and are tied with MC for the league lead with 18 sac flies. Luke Collier leads the GSC with 49 runs scored, 51 hits, 47 RBI and four triples. UWF's Zack Stokes is tops in home runs (12) and walks (31), while standing second in runs scored (40).
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** Lee finishes its seven-game road stretch this weekend before returning home next Tuesday to take on Tusculum University.
