GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee lost two of three last weekend at Mississippi College. The Choctaws won Friday's game 11-7 then claimed the opening game of Saturday's doubleheader 11-5. The Flames used an eight-run fifth inning to avoid the sweep with an 11-7 win in the finale to end a five-game slide.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 6-5 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 46-50 and are 9-9 in neutral-site games. During that period, Lee was 0-2 at Young Harris.
- ➔ **OUT OF CONFERENCE:** The Flames are 8-2 against non-conference opponents. They were just 8-7 outside of conference in the regular season last year and are 64-40 since 2020. Lee has lost its last two non-conference games: 6-5 in 10 innings at Lincoln Memorial (March 3), followed by a 6-5 loss to Carson-Newman on March 10.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Aiden McClary has a current hit streak of 11 games to tie Casen Youngblood and Braden Gabel for the longest streaks of the season. Isaiah French has reached base safely in all 25 of the team's games this season. JJ Williams has reached safely in 14 straight, Aiden McClary 13 and Cody Turner is at 10 in a row.
- ➔ **POWER NUMBERS:** The Flames have posted 30 home runs and are tied for 24th among NCAA DII teams this season. The Mountain Lions lead the country with 59. Keypher Contreras leads DII with 14 home runs. Jackson Morgan (11) and Kade Smallwood (10) join Contreras in the top 10.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return home to host Christian Brothers in a GSC series this weekend.






