- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee lost two of three at Union University over the weekend. After beating UU 13-3 in seven innings in game one, the Bulldogs shut out Lee 4-0 in game two of the doubleheader and completed the series win on Sunday with a 7-6 walk-off win.
- ➔ **HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Lee is 5-3 on the road so far this season. The Flames were 6-15 away from home last year, including an 0-2 record in neutral-site contests. Since 2022, they have an away record of 45-48 and are 9-9 in neutral-site games.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Aiden McClary has a current hit streak of seven games. The longest of the season was 11 by Casen Youngblood and Braden Gabel. Isiah French has reached base safely in all 21 of the team's games this season. JJ Williams has reached safely in 10 straight.
- ➔ **POLL FACTOR:** All six of Lee's losses have come while the Flames were ranked or receiving votes in one of the national polls. Lee was ranked No. 17 in the NCBWA prior to being swept by Delta State. On Tuesday the ABCA poll was released with the Flames receiving votes. Later that day, Lee was handed its fourth loss of the year at LMU and lost two of three at Union over the weekend.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Isaiah French is third in GSC with a batting average of .415, while Braden Gabel is sixth (.391). Luke Collier is first in runs scored (26), while French and Landon Franklin are tied for third with 23. French and Casen Youngblood are tied for fourth with six home runs.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames return to the road traveling to Clinton, Miss., to take on Mississippi College this weekend and Young Harris on March 17.




