GAME NOTES

- ➔ **THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT:** The Flames and Bucs are scheduled for a single nine-inning game on Friday starting at 4 p.m. and a doubleheader (9, 7) on Saturday starting at 1 p.m.
- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee trailed 7-0 after two innings in a 10-4 loss at No. 24/No. 21 Young Harris on Wednesday afternoon. Landon Franklin led Lee with two doubles. Isaiah French had a two-run home run and drove in a third run with an RBI ground out.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee is 10-3 so far this season and were 42-17 at home the previous two seasons. Since 2020, the Flames have a record of 114-47 in games in Larry Carpenter Stadium at Olympic Field.
- ➔ **LOOKING TO TURN THINGS AROUND:** After starting the season 14-3, the Flames have lost seven of their last nine contests.
- ➔ **GONE STREAKING:** Luke Collier and Ryan Valdes own Lee's longest current hitting streaks at five each. Aiden McClary, Casen Youngblood and Braden Gabel have the longest streaks of the season at 11. Isaiah French has reached base safely in all 26 of the team's games this season. JJ Williams has reached safely in 15 straight, McClary 14 and Cody Turner is at 11 in a row.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Isaiah French is third with a batting average of .405 and Braden Gabel is sixth (.383). Luke Collier is tied for first with 30 runs scored and French is third (29). French is tied with four others for first with eight home runs and leads the GSC with 30 RBI.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** After this weekend, the Flames will be on the road for the next eight games before returning home on April 7 against Tusculum for the first of nine straight home games.




