GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee was swept by Delta State in their GSC series. DSU claimed two one-run wins: 4-3 in 10 innings on Friday and 9-8 in the finale on Saturday. The Statesmen won the second game 9-3.
- ➔ **STREAKS:** Lee claimed two weekend sweeps (2-0 against Emmanuel and 3-0 against Tiffin) and picked up a mid-week win against Lincoln Memorial before losing all three games this past weekend.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee is 6-3 so far this season and were 42-17 at home last two seasons. Since 2020, the Flames have posted a record of 110-47 in games in Larry Carpenter Stadium at Olympic Field. Lee is 1-0 at home against North Georgia during that time.
- ➔ **ABOUT NORTH GEORGIA:** UNG claimed a three-game sweep at Embry-Riddle to begin the season. Following a 16-5 loss at home against Young Harris, UNG swept Mississippi College by a combined three-game score total of 37-10. UNG went on the road to beat Young Harris 16-3 and swept Georgia College and State University in a three-game series to start their Peach Belt Conference season.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Isaiah French is tied for third with three home runs. French and Luke Collier are tied with three others for 10th with nine RBI. French is also tied for fourth with nine walks. Collier is tied for second with five stolen bases. Evan Bloomer is tied for first with 19.0 IP and tied for seventh with a 1.89 ERA.
- ➔ **LOOKING AHEAD:** The Flames hit the road for the first time this weekend for a GSC series at UAH followed by a non-conference mid-week contest at Carson-Newman next Tuesday. Lee returns home February 27-28 for a GSC series with AUM.




