## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee held off Trevecca 72-68 on Saturday to end a two-game losing streak. Tylon Chatman led Lee with 17 points to go with three rebounds and five assists. Jamarcus Wilkins added 16 points and six rebounds, while Ben Ritger contributed 15 points.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee is 9-2 at home this season. Since becoming full members of the GSC and NCAA DII in 2015-16, the Flames have amassed a 103-46 record in Walker Arena.
- ➔ **BALANCED SCORING:** The Flames have four players averaging double figures in scoring. Zach Gray is averaging 13.2 ppg, Tylon Chatman (12.9 ppg), Ben Ritger (12.3 ppg) and Willie Walton (10.5 ppg) rounding out the top four. Dayveun Anderson (9.4 ppg) is just below double digits.
- ➔ **POSTSEASON POSITIONING:** UWA, Montevallo, UWF, UAH, Valdosta State and Trevecca have already claimed a berth into the GSC Championships with UWA clinching home court for the quarterfinal round. Lee (8-10) is currently in seventh with Mississippi College (7-12) eighth. Delta State (6-13) and Union (5-13) are just outside the top eight. Lee can clinch a berth with a win plus a loss by Union at UWF.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** DSU's DaCory Porter is fifth in scoring (17.7 ppg). Lee's Willie Walton is eighth in rebounding (6.6 rpg) with DSU's Je'Marion Westbrook is 10<sup>th</sup> (6.4 rpg). Dayveun Anderson (4.1 apg) and Tylon Chatman (3.9 apg) are fifth and sixth in assists. Porter is tied for ninth (3.2 apg).
- ➔ **TEAM SCORING:** Lee is eighth in scoring with 74.4 points per game and are tied for third on defense (72.9 ppg). DSU is 10<sup>th</sup> (73.1 ppg) on offense and seventh offensively (74.4 ppg).
- ➔ **UPCOMING SCHEDULE:** Lee hosts Mississippi College on Saturday for their final regular season home game, before traveling to Christian Brothers and Union next weekend.
