### **GAME NOTES**

- GAME SITUATION: The Flames are playing their third official game of the season, while Lenoir-Rhyne is playing their sixth. This is Lee's first contest against a ranked opponent this season.
- **◆ LAST TIME OUT:** Dayveun Anderson hit a game-winning layup with 1.3 seconds left to give Lee an 83-81 win over Wingate on Friday. The Flames had led by as much as 15 points in the second half and held a 14-point lead with 7:05 remaining. Ben Ritger tallied a career-high 20 points to pace the Lee scoring. Anderson added 17 points to go with six assists. Tylon Chatman (14) and Zach Gray (13) gave Lee four players in double-digits.
- SC PRESEASON: The Flames were predicted to finish fifth this year by the conference's head coaches. Montevallo is the preseason favorite with 114 points. UAH (111) was second, Valdosta State (108) third and West Alabama was fourth (86). Lee amassed 82 points in the voting.
- SC STAT STANDINGS (AS OF NOV. 21): The Flames are sixth in the GSC averaging 83.0 points per game and have allowed the fourth-fewest (70.5 ppg). Lee has made 56.0% of its shots (No. 2) and 38.6% of their 3-point FGs (No. 2). The Flames are also second with 18.50 assists per game and an assist/ turnover ratio of 1.95. Tylon Chatman is tied for 11th in the GSC with 16.0 ppg. Chatman is tied for the league lead with 5.5 assists per game, while Dayveun Anderson is tied for third at 5.0 apg. Lee's top rebrounder Zach Gray is tied for 19th at 5.5 rpg.
- **DUPCOMING SCHEDULE:** The Flames return home on November 25 for another non-conference battle with Claffin University before opening GSC action at home against Montevallo on December 4.
