GAME NOTES

- **GAME SITUATION:** While the Flames open their regular season, Lindsey Wilson is treating tonight's game as an exhibition and it will not affect their overall record.
- **LAST TIME OUT:** Willie Walton hit a three-point shot with eight seconds left in the game to beat Dalton State 76-74 in an exhibition game on November 8. The Flames had four players in double-digit scoring. Zach Gray led all scorers with 21 points, while Tylon Chatman made four three-pointers on his way to 20 points. Dayveun Anderson and Walton added 12 and 11 points, respectively. Anderson tallied nine rebounds and Walton tied Jamarcus Wilkins with seven boards each. Wilkins led the team with five assists and two blocked shots.
- **GSC PRESEASON:** The Flames were predicted to finish fifth this year by the conference's head coaches. Montevallo is the preseason favorite with 114 points. UAH (111) was second, Valdosta State (108) third and West Alabama was fourth (86). Lee amassed 82 points in the voting.
- **ABOUT LINDSEY WILSON:** The Blue Raiders are a member of the Mid-South Conference (MSC) of the NAIA. LWC has three players averaging double-figure scoring: Kenyata Carbon (14 ppg), Julian Cunningham (14.8 ppg) and Latrell Kyles (10.3 ppg). In its six games, the team has averaged 82.3 ppg and have allowed 69.2 ppg. LWC is also outrebounding their opponent by an average of 4.7 rpg.
- **UPCOMING SCHEDULE:** Lee travels to Hickory, N.C., for the Lenoir-Rhyne Classic this weekend (November 21-22). The Flames will play Wingate University followed by host Lenoir-Rhyne. Lee will return home on November 25 for another non-conference battle with Clafin University.

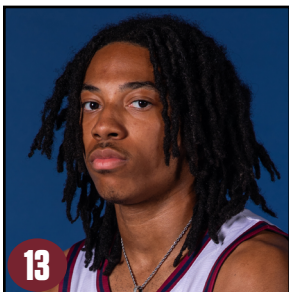
