## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **SENIOR DAY:** The Flames will be recognizing their senior members today. Those set to be honored are Tim Vaughn and Hayden Moseley.
- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee was 2-for-15 from behind the arc in a 68-64 home loss to Delta State on Thursday. Tylon Chatman tallied 13 points, while Zach Gray had 11 points and Dayveun Anderson added 10 more. Willie Walton led Lee with 12 rebounds.
- ➔ **HOME SWEET HOME:** Lee is 9-3 at home this season. Since becoming full members of the GSC and NCAA DII in 2015-16, the Flames have amassed a 103-47 record in Walker Arena.
- ➔ **BALANCED SCORING:** The Flames have four players averaging double figures in scoring. Zach Gray is averaging 13.2 ppg, Tylon Chatman (12.9 ppg), Ben Ritger (12.3 ppg) and Willie Walton (10.5 ppg) rounding out the top four. Dayveun Anderson (9.4 ppg) is just below double digits.
- ➔ **POSTSEASON POSITIONING:** UWA, Montevallo, UWF, UAH, Valdosta State and Trevecca have already claimed a berth into the GSC Championships with UWA clinching home court for the quarterfinal round. Lee (8-11) is currently in seventh with Mississippi College (7-13) and Delta State (7-13) tied for eighth. Union (6-13) are just outside the top eight. Lee can clinch a berth with a win plus a loss by Union at Valdosta State. If Delta State also loses at Trevecca, Lee would clinch the seventh seed.
- ➔ **TEAM SCORING:** Lee is ninth in scoring offense (74.5 ppg), while MC is eighth (74.5 ppg). The Flames scoring defense is third (72.7 ppg) and MC's is 10<sup>th</sup> (80.1 ppg).
- ➔ **UPCOMING SCHEDULE:** Lee travels to Christian Brothers and Union next weekend to complete the regular season schedule.
