GAME NOTES

- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Flames played to a 1-1 tie against Montevallo at home on Friday night. Lee grabbed a 1-0 lead on a goal by Carlos Fernandes in the 30th minute. UM tallied the equalizer in the 69th minute. Lee outshot UM 13-8 and put five shots on goal to four by the visitors. Paul Northcutt recorded three saves.
- ◆ HOME SWEET HOME?: The Flames are 3-3-0 overall this season, but are 2-0-1 in contests played at home. Over the last five seasons, Lee has posted a 19-8-9 record at the Ray Conn Sports Complex.
- Second in the GSC with 87 shots taken and are second with 41 shots on goal. Lee's 12 goals tie them with CBU for third, two goals more than AUM (No. 6). AUM has allowed the fewest goals (four), while Lee is tied for fifth with eight goals allowed. AUM has posted a Save% of .818.
- **➡ ABOUT THE WARHAWKS:** AUM posted its second-straight win with a 2-0 victory Friday evening at Trevecca. The Warhawks have recorded two other shutouts (2-0 against Carson-Newman and 3-0 against Wingate). AUM opened its season with a 3-1 win at Saint Leo and lost 2-1 at Tampa two days later. Between the shutouts of Wingate and Carson-Newman, AUM tied Lander 1-1.
- DIPCOMING DATES: The Flames will be back on the road next weekend, beginning with a date with West Florida on Friday, October 2. Lee will then head west to Mobile, Ala., to battle Spring Hill on Sunday. The Flames' next home game is a non-conference meeting with Lander University on Saturday, October 11.
