**ACTIVE STREAKS** 

- **► LAST TIME OUT:** The Flames hosted Lander University for thier final non-conference matchup of the regular season. The Bearcats scored the lone goal of the match with 20 minutes remaining. The Flames were outshot 11-3 and Lander put five shots on goal to one by Lee. Charles Carriglitto recorded four saves in the loss.
- ◆ HOME SWEET HOME?: The Flames are 4-5-2 overall this season, but are 2-1-2 in contests played at home. Over the last five seasons, Lee has posted a 19-9-10 record at the Ray Conn Sports Complex.
- Take the second the final third of the season: Including tonight, the Flames have five matches remaining in the regular season. The final five are against GSC opponents with three of those set to be played at home.
- PUSH FOR THE POSTSEASON: The Flames enter today in eighth place in the GSC with five points. Spring Hill (1-5-1) and Union (1-3-1) are tied for ninth with four points. Trevecca (1-5) has three points and are 11th. Delta State (0-4-1) is last in the standings with one point, but are still alive for the postseason. The top eight teams earn a berth to the GSC Championships. UAH (2-2-2) and AUM (2-2-2) are tied for sixth with eight points.
- **DUPCOMING DATES:** The Flames travel to Mississippi next weekend for their final two road contests of the season. Lee will take on MC on Friday then move on to Delta State on Sunday. The Flames return home on October 31 to take on the Union Bulldogs.






