- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Lady Flames beat West Alabama 3-1. Lee hit .301 in the game. Esthefany Rabit had ten kills and eight blocks. Sophia Lippert had her highest kill mark of the year with 15.
- FIRST MEETING: In the opening contest of GSC play, Lee battled from behind in the fifth set to claim a victory over CBU. Lee trailed 7-4 in the final set before staging a tremendous rally for the thrilling 15-13 win.
- **➡ BALANCED ATTACK:** Payton Danley is 11th in the GSC in kills with 100. Her hitting percentage is .283 which is tenth best. Five other players have 90 or more kills for Lee. Three players for Lee have 150 or more assists on the season as well. Six have double digit aces.
- **BLOCKING:** Lee is thid in blocks with 116 in the GSC. They are fourth in blocks per set in the GSC at 1.97 and Esthefany Rabit is seconds in blocks in the GSC with 55 while Naomi Hockless is tenth.
- SCOUTING THE BUCS: CBU leads the GSC in service aces with 125 and are 19th in the nation. They average 2.16 aces per set. Ava Hillyer has 25 while Sarah Helms has 23.
- UP NEXT: The Lady Flames will remain on the road at take on AUM in Montgomery on Friday.


