- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Lady Flames rallied to beat CBU on Tuesday. It marked the fourth time this season the Lady Flames have played five-set contests and Tuesday's win was their first five-set win. It was the overall play of Sara Palumbo. The sophomore finished the evening with 14 kills and an attack mark of .308. Her 12 digs gave her a double-double plus she came away with four service aces.
- STRONG ATTACK: The Lady Flames are third in the GSC in hitting percentage at .216. Teams are only hitting .145 against Lee. The Lady Flames are third in the GSC in aces with 70. Payton Danley is ninth in kills in the GSC. Sydney Sharpe, Berra Soyler, and Madison Dahl all have over 100+ assists.
- SCOUTING THE BUCS: UAH took all three GSC weekly awards this past week. UAH is second in the GSC in attack percentage at .222 and kills with 504. Caroline Moyer leads the GSC and is 15th in the nation in kills with 160. Alex McGeehan has 36 blocks which is second best in the GSC.
- UP NEXT: Lee will head to Montevallo on Saturday to take on the University of Montevallo. Then next Tuesday they will go to the Music City to take on Trevecca Nazarene University.


