- ◆ LAST TIME OUT: The Lady Flames' nine-match win streak ended following a 0-0 tie with #22 Embry-Riddle (Fla.) last Saturday, Lee outshot ERAU 15-7 and placed seven shots on goal to four by the Eagles. Abby Whitcomb recorded four saves to post her sixth shutout of the season.
- FINAL TWO WEEKENDS OF SEASON: The Lady Flames have just four matches (all within the GSC) remaining on the schedule. The Lady Flames enter the day in fourth place with 16 points in the GSC. West Florida (9-0-1) and Montevallo (7-2-2) has clinched two of the eight GSC Championship berths. West Alabama (6-2-1) is third with 19 points. Right behind Lee is Spring Hill (4-2-3) with 15 points. UAH (4-4-1) is in sixth position with 13 points with Delta State (3-2-3) seventh (12) and MC holding the eighth spot with 11 points. Union (2-5-1) and Trevecca (1-3-4) are tied for ninth with seven points.
- Second with UWF's Olof Thoraldsdottir with nine goals. With her four goals Wednesday night, MC's Addison Weems has moved into fourth position with eight goals. Nye is also second in the GSC with four game-winning goals. Megan Davis is tied for third with five assists and Grace Berry is tied for fifth with four assists. Avery Sides' three assists puts her in a three-way tie for eighth.
- UPCOMING DATES: The Lady Flames remain in Mississippi for a battle with Delta State on Sunday. Next weekend Lee hosts Union (Friday) and Christian Brothers (Sunday) for their final regular season contests.
