## GAME NOTES

- ➔ **LAST TIME OUT:** The Lady Flames handed Montevallo their first GSC loss of the season by a 3-1 margin on Wednesday. Alaysia Nye scored twice and Nora Burton added one more to give Lee a 3-0 lead a little over 32 minutes in. UM tallied a goal at 34:08 and that was the final tally. UM outshot Lee 15-7 and put five shots on goal to four for Lee.
- ➔ **OVER HALFWAY THROUGH SEASON:** The Lady Flames have just four matches (all within the GSC) remaining on the schedule after today's non-conference date with ERAU. As of Thursday, Lee was in third place with 16 points. Montevallo (7-1-1) was first with 22 points and West Florida (6-0-1) was third (16). West Alabama and UAH were tied with 13 points (4-2-1) for fourth place. The top eight teams will earn a spot in the GSC Championship.
- ➔ **GSC STAT LEADERS:** Alaysia Nye's two goals on Wednesday helped her regain the GSC lead with nine goals. She also is tied for first with four game-winning goals. Megan Davis is tied for second with five assists.
- ➔ **NCAA DII RANKINGS:** The Lady Flames did not receive votes in the Soccer Coaches Top 25 for the second straight week. The Lady Flames were ranked #13 four weeks ago. Embry-Riddle is #22 in this week's poll after receiving votes last week.
- ➔ **ABOUT THE EAGLES:** Embry-Riddle is yet to lose this season. They have posted wins against Columbus State, Tampa, Lynn, Flagler and Eckerd; while tying West Florida, Valdosta State, Florida Tech, Barry and Palm Beach Atlantic.
- ➔ **UPCOMING DATES:** The Lady Flames travel to Mississippi next weekend to play MC on Friday and Delta State on Sunday. Lee returns home on October 31 to take on Union University.

The Lady Flames recorded a 2-0 shutout in the 2006 season and posted two more shutouts during the 2011 season. Lee won the regular season contest at home 3-0 and won 2-0 in the NAIA Tournament. The Eagles grabbed a 3-1 win in 2012 and a 1-0 double-overtime win in 2017. ERAU beat Lee 2-1 in the Second Round of the 2019 NCAA Championship.

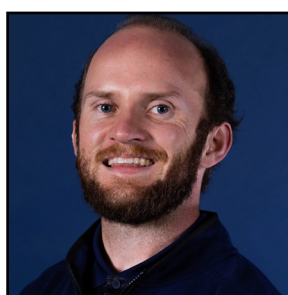
