## GAME NOTES

- **LAST TIME OUT:** Lee opened GSC play with a 1-0 win at AUM on Saturday. The Flames outshot the Warhawks 14-2 with nine shots on goal to one for the home side. Lee tallied the game-winning goal in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute off a free kick by Megan Davis that was redirected into the right corner for what was ruled an own goal.
- **LOOKING TO MAKE HISTORY:** The Lee women enter tonight one win shy of posting the program's 500<sup>th</sup> victory. In their 35<sup>th</sup> season, the Lee women have amassed a record of 499-161-51.
- **HOME SWEET HOME:** The Flames are 1-0 this season and were 7-1-1 in contests played at home last season. Over the last six seasons, Lee has posted a 36-6-7 record at the Ray Conn Sports Complex.
- **LEE IN THE IWSOC COACHES POLL:** Despite their win at AUM, the Lee women dropped one spot in the Intercollegiate Women's Soccer Organization for Coaches (IWSOC) Poll from being tied at No. 9 last week to No. 10 this week. The No. 10 ranking was the highest for Lee since they hit No. 9 in Poll 7 (Oct. 17) of the 2023 season.
- **GSC STAT LEADERS:** The Flames are third in the GSC with 1.750 goals/game and allow 0.750 goals/game (No. 1). They are fourth with 4.50 points/game. Megan Davis is tied for ninth with two goals, tied for second with one game-winning goal and is tied for 12<sup>th</sup> with four points. Abby Whitcomb is third in the conference with a goals against average of 0.75. She has recorded eight saves after facing 11 shots on goal through four games (360 minutes played).
- **ABOUT THE TIGERS:** West Alabama recorded a 1-0 win over Kentucky Wesleyan in their season opener before dropping the last three contests, including a 4-1 non-conference loss at Montevallo. They lost the last two contests by 1-0 margins at USC Beaufort and this past Friday at UAH. Goalkeeper Yumari Hernandez is second in the GSC with 26 saves and is first with 6.50 saves per game.
- **UPCOMING DATES:** The Flames return to the road with matches at Montevallo (Sept. 19) and at Trevecca Nazarene (Sept. 23). The next home game for Lee is scheduled for Sat., Sept. 26 against Mississippi Christian.

- **SERIES STREAKS:** Lee has won all 12 meetings in the all-time series. Four of the wins were 1-0 scores, while last year's 2-1 win was the fifth contest decided by one goal. Overall, the Flames have outscored West Alabama 35-6 with eight total shutouts. Lee has allowed just one goal (3-1 in 2015) in games played in Cleveland. The Flames have amassed a scoring differential of 15-1, including a 6-0 mark in 2016, in those six home contests against UWA.
